

in the town of Bethel. Q: What do public health investigations involve/include?

Investigations include:

(1) Review of existing public health records/documents.

(2) Site Inspection/investigation by trained staff

(3) Identification and confirmation of any Public Health Code violations as

defined in the Connecticut General Statues, Connecticut Public Health Code, and Town of Bethel ordinances.

(4) Issuance of orders by the Director of Health to correct or eliminate the violation(s) noted

(5) If orders are not complied with, the Director of Health and the Town

Attorney start legal proceeding against the violator to the Superior Court, and, if necessary, continue the legal process through the court system. (6) Immediate health hazards are addressed by the Director of Health working in conjunction with the Town Attorney.

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
